

Reading Inventory Growth Slides Intervention teacher who focuses her attention on reading at this time (Mrs. Blake) Getting students 2 grade levels or below extra time

54% are unduplicated (English Language learners, homeless or low socio-economic status) Can receive funds for Title 1 school even though don't hit 68% mark that is recognized federally

**Assessments**: ELs take the ELPAC exam to measure progress towards Eng-lish language proficiency. The ELPAC has 4 levels.

**ELPI Levels** 

Takes 4-7 years for typical student reclassification
Previous way ranking students didn't show growth
Now looking at cohorts & making growth levels – great way to measure how we're doing as a site 52.8% of students made at least one level of growth
