7. Principal's Report – Alex Peck

-Questions around curtains being made – currently in MPR and will be on a pully system (not automatic).

-Suggestions to partner with Sweet Water if we want wireless mics – they give discounts -On Sunday, shared team of Ms Martha & Ms Kassy going to TK/K to discuss safe touch; going through grade levels, changing lessons to be grade appropriate. Mrs. Ervin had it today & said it was wonderful. Will be following up with another activity so it connects with the kids. Ms Kassy will send out a brief rundown of the language being used to parents can speak with their children. -Capital Projects Committee – will need team of folks to join. Coleman is up to have some remodeling take place & possibly adding new buildings. Input from community will be very important. More info to be shared via Principal Update & Parent Square

-Friday, Feb 17th, will have Coleman Play Day. Last 2 hours dedicated to the event. Students trained in 2nd round (how to be support & leaders while playing games like 4 square, soccer & basketball) & they will lead those 2 hours. Responsible for knowing the rules & helping students with conflicts that arise during the games. Intent for students to gain leadership skills & make Coleman a safe happy place while playing on the playground.

-Walker Creek for 5th grade families April $3^{rd} - 6^{th}$ Able to get 54 students from the high school to volunteer & will limit to 16 students. Outdoor Ed for all students in SR city schools. Students stay for 3 nights with cabin leaders & 5th grade teachers. Students participate in activities around ecology, hiking & learning about environment around them.

-Exec Board requested field trip information (#s by grades) – colleting to share with families so know how funds from PTO are being spent

-Response from hate speech taking place. Initial step was appropriate disciplinary actions. Then notified all families through Parents Square communication. Real work is how we educate our students and further develop staff & communities around anti-racist work. Has reached out to some partners and on Wednesday will meet with Dr. Lori Watson at Race Work. Then will meet with group of community members to see if that is who we want to partner with moving forward. More info to follow.

Kelly Whelan – Upcoming opportunities to support teachers in all of San Rafael Elementary & Middle School teachers belong to 1 Union (1 bargaining unit) In middle of negotiating new working contract

Currently # of issues agreeing upon (teachers & the district) but one major area not reaching agreement, in the area of salary & compensation of teachers

Union & district at an impasse – will be bringing in a state mediator to help

Hope mediation process results are good for both parties.
