Behind the scenes – finance management, bookkeeping, reimbursement management process, expense checks

Total expenses to date: \$51,325.67 (~29% of budget)

Key expenses: Art/Music \$25K; \$2.8K Classroom discretionary (each teacher receives about \$1k + ~\$200 for class parties + more for field trips); \$1.35K Community events; \$2.77K Operating & Accounting; \$8.4K Coleman Merchandise (little higher than budget but making income with merchandise)

Fundraising Goals: Goal \$180,500 (what need to provide services for next year) & 100% participation; Tiger Fund Goal (373 students; \$400/student)

Total income to date \$84,171.60 (~47% of goal)

Key fundraising events to date: ~ \$24KColeman Carnival, ~\$50K Tiger Fund, ~\$2K Margarita Mamas; ~\$7K Coleman merchandise; TBD Dine & Donate; \$1K Movie Night Any questions: colemanschooltreasurer@gmail.com

-Attendance – 92-94% attendance; important since funded by kids on campus; average 96-98% so Coleman is low

-Tiger Teams Junior Coaches – have met 3 times to create rules with group of students; shirts purchased (will tye-dye) for kids who participate; Google form will go out for next group of 30 students to sign up

-Roundabout Update – going smoothly – suggestion is park on Belle do so before 7:50; parking of Rafael, tickets were given out from 8-4; have done walk through on Safe Routes – will reach out to have meeting school wide & bring plan to city council
