MINUTES

1. Welcome and Introductions - Tracy (5 min)

Welcome and thank you for joining us for tonight's meeting!

3. Update from Zero Waste - Laura, Kelsey (7 min)

Kelsey is Coleman's contact/liaison with Zero Waste Schools Program and SEI. They are working with over 40 public schools in Marin County. They support schools so staff, teachers, and students have resources, equipment, and training to reduce waste sent to the landfill.

Zero Waste piloted a program at Coleman that doesn't exist at any other school - they gave out reusable utensils or a reusable snack bag to empower students to reduce waste and make a difference for our environment.

Coleman achieved the Gold level certification from Zero Waste this year! This is an especially big achievement because it's an improvement from Bronze level last year. Congrats to the Green Team who led the efforts and all Coleman students and staff who supported and participated in reducing waste at Coleman.

Zero Waste offers compostable plates and utensils for school events, usually limited to one or two school events per year. Need to submit request 4 weeks in advance. Can look into partnering on buying in bulk and passing the discounted price along for Coleman PTO to purchase compostable plates, cutlery, and possibly cups for Coleman's additional events.

4. Fundraising / Finance Update - Tracy (5 min)

We fundraise in Arrears which means the money we raise this year is used for next year's PTO budget. Last year we raised \$221K. Our approved budget for this year was \$250K (using some PTO reserves to fund this year's budget and we are coming in under budget in a few areas for this year's budget).

We had a stretch fundraising goal for this year to raise \$250K. So far, we have passed \$200K this year. We are hoping to raise as much this year as possible because we want to maintain the level of reserves the PTO has especially given the reductions to the district budget we know are coming in the next couple of years.

Last year, at the same point in the year, we had raised over \$85K in Tiger Fund contributions. So far this year, we have raised \$70K in Tiger Fund donations, so we're trending a bit behind.

Since the initial communication went out that we're below our fundraising goal last week, we've already raised an additional \$1,000. If you're able to make another donation (big or small), please contribute what you're able.
