- <u>What is SSC</u>? Parents & School Staff who develop a school plan for submission to SRCS School Board. Mandated by the state. Writes school plan, Develops Budget, Evaluates effectiveness of improvement efforts and Develops the site safety plan.
- What is SELAC? School English Learner Advisory Committee. Parents, Teachers and staff whose main concerns are the welfare of the school's English Language Learners
- 2016 Coleman Parent Survey:
 - o All questions are being asked at every school in the district.
 - o Marta has been VERY helpful getting responses from Spanish speaking parents.
 - o 167 Responses out of 407 students (considered high)

- Family Engagement

- o Overall there seems to be a high level of family engagement & involvement in the school
 - Working parents have trouble participating (8 comments)
 - Positive Community Environment (5 comments)

- School Climate

- o High respect by students of staff, staff of students.
- 29% of Spanish Speaking parents believe the school climate is 'unwelcoming'
 - Desire for greater cultural sensitivity (5 comments)
 - Concern about testing frequency & quantities (5 comments)
- **Grade Level Satisfaction**: Kindergarten is highest
- **Enrichment**: Art is highest, technology not considered
- **Communication, Recess:** majority feel meets expectations
 - Recess experience needs improvement (7 comments)
 - Music Program needs improvement (5 comments)

- Demographics

- Slight increase in male respondents
- o 42% of Kindergarten pardents responded, the highest, 12% in 5th grade, the lowest

- Gratitude (7 comments)
- Discipline and Behavior need improvement (5 comments)
- Advanced Learning Opportunities desired (5 comments)
